



## Key Points to Remember about Digital Forensics

### Protecting Your Case's Digital Evidence

- Digital forensic evidence strengthens most legal cases.
- 95% of the evidence in civil cases is in electronic form.
- Look for all digital evidence; e.g., PDAs, phones, cameras, etc.!
- Digital media must be properly secured and verified or admissibility of any information on it as evidence may be lost!
- Secure and preserve all digital evidence as soon as possible to prevent spoliation!
- Do not attempt to conduct your own forensics examination!
- Do not open files!
- Do not copy files!
- **THEREFORE** — Contact your digital forensics expert *ASAP* in the case to prevent spoliation and defeat!
